This list provides a selection of continuing education opportunities that are known to the Nevada Division of Water Resources. It does not provide a list of every opportunity available to a driller. It is acceptable to obtain CE from sources not on this list as long as it pertains to well drilling and is approved by the State Engineer's office either before or after the class is taken. This list will be updated regularly on our web site at [water.nv.gov](http://water.nv.gov) and a revised list sent to licensed drillers annually. Copies of the current approved list can be requested at any time by calling our office 775-684-2800.

\*\*A class on Nevada Well Drilling Regulations is required at least once every two years. State-sponsored courses will be offered at least once every year.

**Notes:** Eight CE credits are required each year to renew a driller's license. Generally, one hour of training is equivalent to one credit. At least two separate classes (topics) must be taken each cycle to obtain the required credits. The required regulation class must be taken at least once every two years. A maximum of 4 CE credits can carry over from one licensing cycle to the next. It is the responsibility of the driller to maintain documentation of education and keep track of credits. Proper documentation can include the completed documentation form provided by the state for each class, diplomas, certificates, rosters, transcripts, etc. Drillers must provide copies of this documentation with their renewal application.
