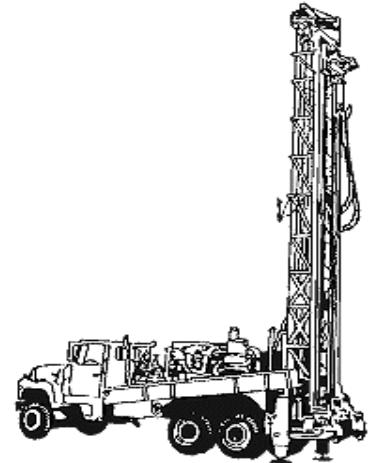

2018-2019 Examination Dates and Times

Written exams for parts I and II of the well driller examination are offered in January, March, April, June, July, September, October and December. The exam will begin promptly at 8:30.

The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board meets in February, May, August and November to conduct part III of the well driller examination. The oral exam is scheduled by appointment.

Who to contact within the Well Drilling Section of the Nevada Water Resources

Janice Willhite is the Administrative Assistant for the Well Drilling Section. Mike Scott is still handling the reviewing/processing of all NOI's and well logs, as well as well inspections in all of northern Nevada. Jake Echeverria is now handling all well driller licensing and CEU duties. Ken Haffey is still responsible for processing waiver requests, as well as tracking and issuing well driller demerits. In southern Nevada Christi Cooper processes all NOI cards and Well Logs, and Tracy Geter handles all of the waivers. Tim Wilson is still the manager of the Well Drilling Section.

At the Nevada Division of Water Resources Well Drilling Program we are striving toward making this a better program, and we ask that if you have any thoughts, ideas or concerns, give us a call so that we may address those issues.

Required Courses

The required regulation workshop will remain one four hour course, three hours covering the regulations portion and one hour covering the forms portion. You will receive 4 Continuing Education Units (CEU's) for attending this workshop. All well drillers can check the status of their license, which will show how many CEU's they have, and if they need the required Regulations and forms class at <http://water.nv.gov/continuingeducation.aspx>.
