Frank Pastorini owned formerly the lands now owned by John Venturino, Antonio Tognoni and Pete Edera, and, one Dominico Depoali was then the owner of an upper ranoh, now called the Depoali Ranoh and which remains intact. The said owners of these ranohes in 1877, appropriated all of the waters of Simpson Springs and Simpson Creek for use on said ranohes, and apportioned the same so that each year commencing about March 1st, the upper, or Depoali Ranoh, used all of said water for three successive days, ~~and then, the lower or Pastorini Ranoh used the same for three successive days.~~ Each owner of the use of the water for said times, was required to do the labor of diverting the water for his use. The returning point to Simpson Creek is on the Depoali Ranoh.

Subsequently, the Pastorini Ranoh was sub-divided and finally became three ranohes which are owned at the present time by John Venturino, Antonio Tognoni and Pete Edera. This claimant is the owner of one of the sub-divisions of said Pastorini Ranoh. The water right for said lands so owned by said Pastorini was sub-divided so that the upper sub-division of said ranoh became entitled to the use of all of said water for one day of the time formerly the same as used by Frank Pastorini; the next sub-division became entitled to the use of all of the water for the second day of the time the same was used by said Pastorini; and the third sub-division became entitled to the use of all of the water for the third day of the time the same was used by the said Pastorini. Each right appurtenant to the said lands so sub-divided, rotated so that the user thereof for the first day became entitled ~~the~~ to the use for the third of the next succeeding year, the second was advanced to the first day, and the third user was advanced to the ^{second} ~~first~~ day. Each day commenced at the hour of 6 o'clock P.M., and continued for the full 24 hours. After the use of all of the said water by the owners of said Pastorini lands, so sub-divided, for three days, the use of said water was returned to the Depoali Ranoh for the next following three days, and then in turn to the lower ranohes, and, so continued for each irrigating season until and including the date hereof. In other words, the owners of the sub-divided ranoh succeeded to the rights of said Frank Pastorini in and to the use of said water.

The following abstract comprises all of the claims in and to water from Simpson Creek, Elko County, Nevada.

In this compilation we have listed each claim to water in the alphabetical order of the claimant's name, giving the year the right was initiated, the amount of land cultivated the first year of initiation of the water right, and the amount of land reclaimed in subsequent years. Also, we have included a compilation showing the number of claimants under each year from the earliest year shown in any proof, to the present time.

In some cases, areas are included which do not agree with the areas shown by the maps filed, and notes appear in this abstract whenever there is a difference in area between the proofs and the maps. In the event that no showing is made to the contrary, the areas taken from the maps will be deemed correct, notwithstanding the claims in the proofs.

A copy of this compilation will be mailed or delivered in person to each and every water user, whose name appears in the abstract, for his consideration. ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1, 1913, all objections to claims listed in this abstract, must be filed with the State Engineer, at Carson City, Nevada.

The objection against a finding for any claim as it appears in the abstract must be in writing, and must clearly and concisely set forth the reasons for such protest. The statement objecting to any claim must be signed and acknowledged before an officer authorized to administer oaths.

A date will be set for the hearing of protests, should such be filed, but such date shall not be less than fifteen days after the date for filing protests has elapsed. The parties to the contention will be notified in writing to appear at a date and place designated by the State Engineer, when the claimant shall have the right to furnish evidence concerning the contested claims, and the protestant shall be entitled to produce such evidence as may tend to substantiate his contention.

Immediately after the conclusion of the hearings, or as soon thereafter as conditions will permit, the State Engineer will render his findings in an "Abstract of findings to claims", which will be the decree of the State Engineer as to the relative rights of each user.

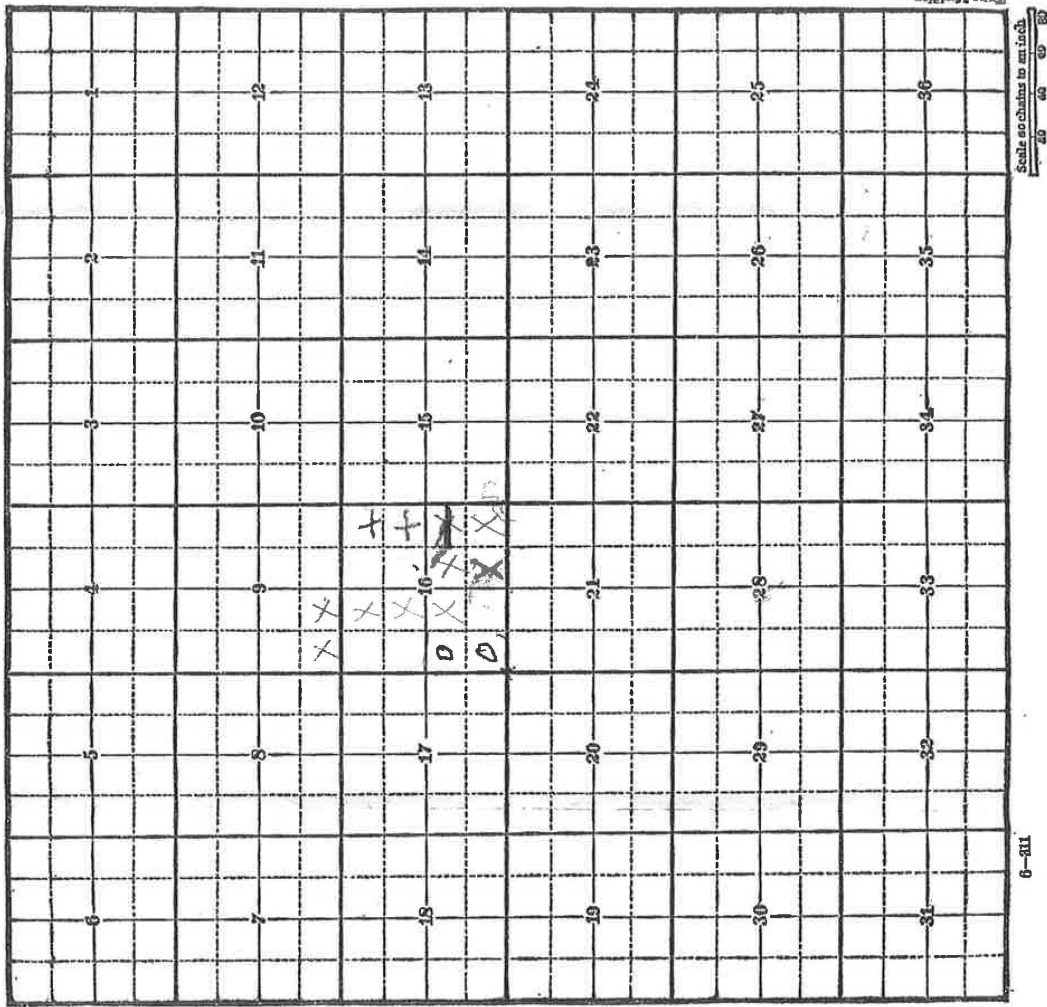
