This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all prior rights on the source. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. It is distinctly understood that applicant agrees to the terms herein contained.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 23, 1926

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 23, 1926

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 23, 1926

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 23, 1926

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

July 23, 1927

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 23, 1927

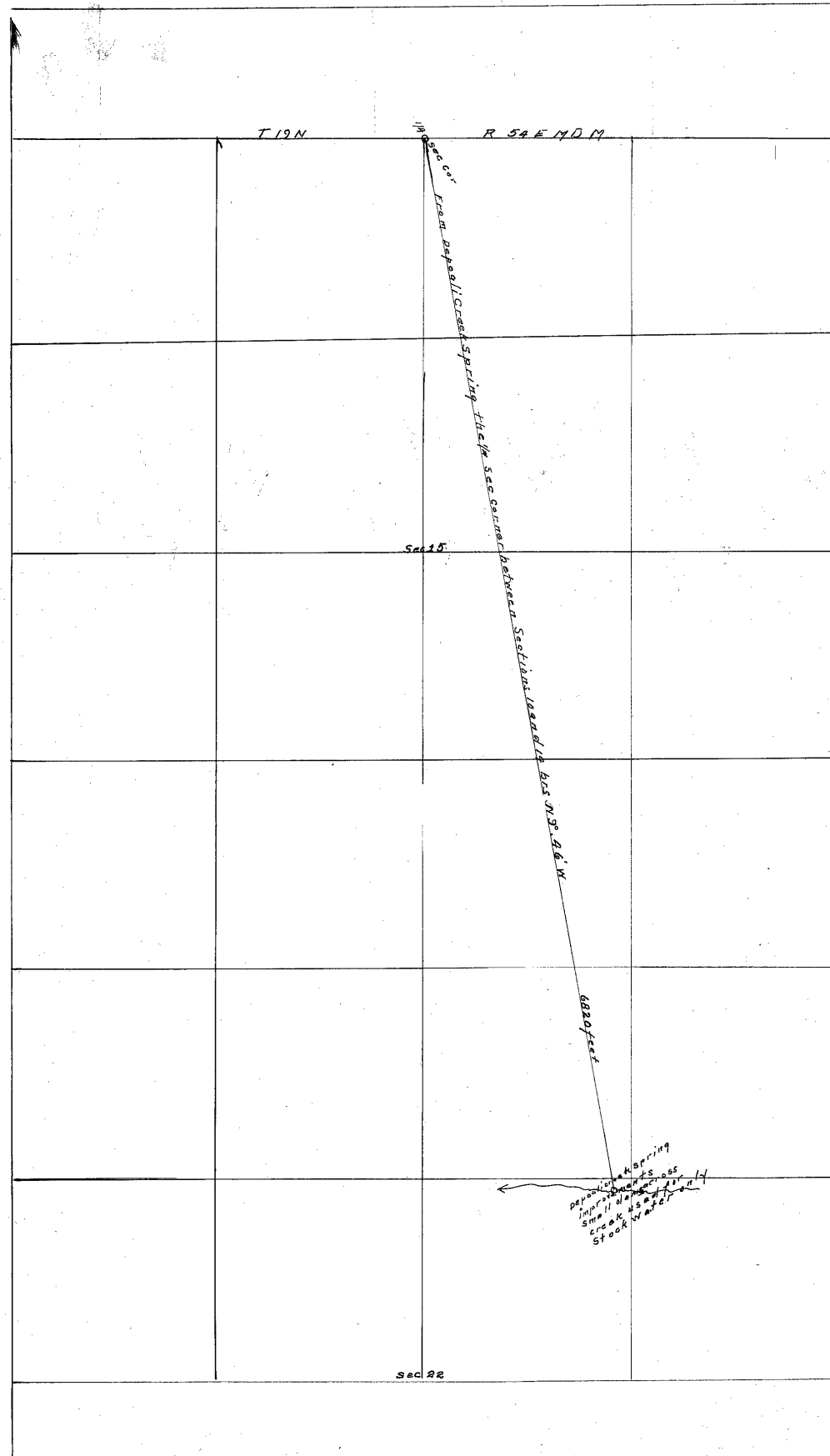

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS James Hunter has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Depaoli Creek Spring

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 19 N., R. 54 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point that bears S. 9°-46' E., 6820 ft. from the North 1/4 Cor. Sec. 15, T. 19 N., R. 54 E., M. D. B. & M.

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James Hunter

Post-office address Eureka, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.003 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 cattle.

Period of use, from April 1 to October 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 31, 1924.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: -
 Spring developed by means of a cut 6 feet long, 3 feet wide and 1 1/2 feet deep. A dirt dam 16 feet in length and 5 feet high constructed across the channel of Depaoli Creek, 40 feet below the Spring creating a small reservoir. Place of use located in the SW 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 19 N., R. 54 E., M. D. B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
