





The waters from the Angelo Billy Springs were always claimed by us as the waters came into our canyon through the mud springs section. Our cattle and stock watered at these waters all through the years that we remained on the ranch. In the spring of the year, the waters from this channel ran into the main stream above the old picnic grounds.

The Spanish Gulch spring, even though taken up by Florio, was always in my estimation a water that was used by our stock and the original channel ran into our ranch, as well as the Cottonwood spring. My dad and I in the early 1900's made a dtich for the Cottonwood Spring and also brought that water into the Spanish Gulch canyon and used the waters for irrigation.

I believe that the vested rights in the above mentioned waters definitely belong to the Bar C Ranch as the waters followed the natural channels to the ranch.
