One of our favorite spots to explore was around Milk Ranch Canyon near where Richmond, Bullwhacker, Lani, Middle and Fred Springs are located. While exploring the Milk Ranch Canyon and in and around those springs during the spring, summer and fall of the year, we always encountered the Hunter Cattle grazing or watering or bedded down during the heat of the day.

As a teenager I spent time at the Hunter Ranch, located on Simpson Creek in Eureka County, and I helped the Hunters gather their cattle which would consist of horseback riding in the Spanish Gulch Allotment and south past the Milk Ranch Canyon to the White Pine County Line, north to the Cottonwood Ranch, which is in the Shannon Station Allotment, and east to Newark Summit to the Eureka County line and west to Devil's Gate and west Diamond Valley.

As an adult, I married and became a local business man and raised my family in the community of Eureka until I left Eureka in 2008, although I still own property in the Eureka area.

Around 1974, the Baumanns purchased the Hunter Ranch, and I can vouch that the Baumanns utilized the same grazing allotments and the same springs as the Hunters did in their ranching operation.
