TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Whereas, ANDREW C. DIBBLE of SUREKA County NEVADA has deposited with the Register of the State Land Office at Carson City the State Treasurer's receipt, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said ANDREW C. DIBBLE according to the provisions of an Act of the Legislature, approved March 12, 1885, entitled "An act to provide for the selection and sale of lands that have been or may hereafter be granted by the United States to the State of Nevada," and the Acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto. For the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Ten (10), Township Twentyfour (24) North, Range Fiftyfour (54) East.

Mount Diablo base and meridian, containing Forty acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the Public Lands, as made by the United States Surveyor-General for the District of Nevada, which said tract has been purchased by the said Andrew C. Dibble

Therefore, know ye, That the State of Nevada, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the Act of the Legislature in such cases made and provided, has given and granted, and by these presents does give and grant, unto the said Andrew C. Dibble and to his heirs, the said tract above described,

To Have and to Hold the same, together with all rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Andrew C. Dibble and to his heirs and assigns forever; provided that all mines of gold, silver, copper, lead, cinnabar and other valuable minerals that may exist in said tract, and also right-of-way for ditches, tunnels and telephone and transmission lines constructed by authority of the United States are hereby expressly reserved.
