Dear Mr. Boyle:

As you know, on September 2, 2011, the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation ("NFWF") requested that the Walker River Irrigation District (the "District") provide certain information to UNR-DRI in connection with the model it is developing sometimes referred to as the "Decision Support Tool" ("DST/Model"). That information relates to Certificate Water and/or Excess Water<sup>1</sup> for the period 1996 through 2010.

Delivered herewith is the following information for use by UNR-DRI in connection with the DST/Model:

1. A thumb drive which includes monthly information concerning diversions by ditch with respect to "Decree, Storage and Permit Water" for the years 2009 and 2010; and

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<sup>1</sup> Certificate Water is water diverted under Nevada Certificates of Appropriation Nos. 8859 and 8860 held by the District. Excess Water is water made available under the 1953 Rules and Regulations for the Distribution of Water on the Walker River System as approved by the Walker River Court. Sometimes Certificate Water and/or Excess Water is also referred to as "flood water." The records which are delivered herewith refer to Certificate Water and/or Excess Water as "Permit Water." This letter therefore refers to "Permit Water."

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
