Re: *Great Basin Water Network v. State Engineer*

Dear Mr. Herskovits and Mr. Taggart:

The State Engineer hereby sets the following schedule for addressing the Great Basin Water Network, et al.'s (GBWN) *Motion for Declaratory Order on Scope and Implementation of Remedy Ordered by Supreme Court*.

The State Engineer previously expressed his concern that the motion had not been served on all who could be affected by the motion, for example, the Moapa Band of Paiute Indians, which now holds one permit and one application in the California Wash Hydrographic Basins, which were part of the original Las Vegas Valley Water District 1989 applications. By letter received this date the GBWN responded to the State Engineer's letter and indicated that the GBWN does not intend to assert that the permit and application now held by the Moapa Band of Paiute Indians are included within the group of applications it alleges are at issue. The GBWN's letter demonstrates there is confusion as to which 1989 applications the GBWN believes are at issue.


