It's important for me that the Great Basin water stays in the Great Basin.

Southern Nevada can do so much more to conserve water, and yet we are not. For example, last week I read in the Las Vegas Review Journal that two huge water park projects have been approved; one in Henderson, and one in the Summerlin area. These are totally inappropriate in our desert, and during this drought.
