

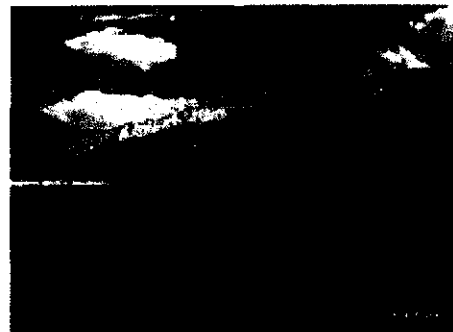


Protect the Great Basin!
