It's important for me that the Great Basin water stays in the Great Basin because of the personal experience that I have of the area as a former Tribal Preservation Officer from 1993 to 1997. The area of BLM land I covered during those years expresses to me that the cultural, natural and historical areas of Northeastern Nevada must not be furthered disturbed or violated by projects that are not justified or will provide any economical future for future generations.

I urge you to deny the applications filed by the Southern Nevada Water Authority and support the best interests of all of Nevada.
