Re: Scheduling

Dear Ms. Joseph-Taylor:

At our last status hearing, you suggested counsel should try to get together and agree on a schedule for the exchange of reports and rebuttal reports.

To that end, I have conferred with Paul Taggart and Dana Walsh, who represent SNWA. We did not come to an agreement because of our different views on prepared written testimony and pre-hearing discovery. I contemplated something like this:

- 1. Initial reports and prepared testimony to be exchanged about May 15, 2017;
- 2. Rebuttal reports to follow 45 days later, or June 30;
- 3. Discovery to be permitted from June 1 through August 15.1

Inasmuch as counsel for SNWA has determined that they do not favor prepared written testimony or pre-hearing discovery, they have no enthusiasm for this schedule. I believe that they will submit a separate proposal suggesting initial reports to be filed 60 days before the hearing and rebuttals 30 days before the hearing (or something similar).
