CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clal. E. Georgetta has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring Creek through Spring Creek Ditch and Narrows Ditch for stockwatering

purpose. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 19, T. 11 S. R. 19 W., S.L.B.M., or at a point that bears S. 36° 18' E., 5.569 feet from the N.W. Corner Section 19, T. 11 S; R. 19 W., S.L.B.M. situated in Juab County, State of Nevada, Utah.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Clal. E. Georgetta
Post office address: Ithapa, Utah
Amount of appropriation: 0.029 of a cubic foot of water per second or 28.47 acre feet per annum.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 25, 1880.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from Spring Creek in the State of Utah and conveyed by means of Spring Creek Ditch into the State of Nevada, where it is delivered to a reservoir for the watering of 50 horses, 100 cattle and 5,000 sheep. Spring Creek Ditch delivers water to Reservoir No. 1 (30' x 50' x 10') NE 1/4 Section 15, T. 23 N., R. 70 E., S. 150' x 50' x 5'; NE 1/4 Section 22, T. 23 N., R. 70 E., S. 100' x 100' x 5'; NE 1/4 Section 24, T. 24 N., R. 70 E., S. 100' x 100' x 5'; NE 1/4 Section 25, T. 24 N., R. 70 E., S. 100' x 100' x 5'. The Narrows Ditch diverts from Spring Creek Ditch, and delivers water to Reservoir No. 2 (20' x 120' x 10'), SW 1/4 Section 22, T. 23 N., R. 70 E., S. 100' x 100' x 5'; SW 1/4 Section 23, T. 23 N., R. 70 E., S. 100' x 100' x 5'; SW 1/4 Section 24, T. 24 N., R. 70 E., S. 100' x 100' x 5'; SW 1/4 Section 25, T. 24 N., R. 70 E., S. 100' x 100' x 5'. In addition to the above specified quantity of water for actual use for stockwatering purposes, the appropriation is entitled to divert a sufficient quantity of water to take care of any reasonable transportation loss, but in no event shall such diversion exceed 3.00 cubic feet per second. In issuing this certificate, it has been recognized that the State Engineer of Nevada has jurisdiction over the water of this source only after the same has entered the said State of Nevada.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified; and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which required.
