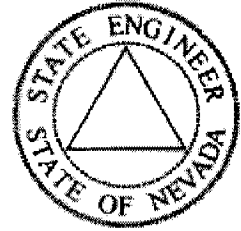

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all prior rights. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water here-in granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 water cubic feet per second, or sufficient to 2500 head of sheep and 500 head of cattle.
Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 1, 1928
Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 1, 1928
Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1928
Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 1, 1928
Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 1, 1929. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before November 1, 1929

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72 Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.05 of a cubic foot of water per second of time.

Period of use, from March 1st to November 30th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 1, 1927.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Consist of a cased well 36 feet deep and equipped with three cylinder pump, horse power and 100 feet of 20 inch trough used for watering 5500 sheep and 500 head of cattle.

The above described works are located at the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.

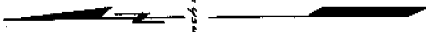
