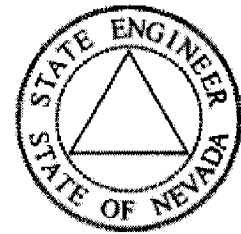

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.1 c.f.s. of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependant upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 24, 1949

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 24, 1949

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 24, 1950

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 24, 1950

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Robert F. Stopper, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from _____ an underground source through well, pump, pipe line, tank for _____ mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T. 11 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner of said Section 12, bears N. 21 $^{\circ}$ 40' E., 920.00 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a well 4 feet in diameter and dug to a depth of 18 feet; thence drilled an additional 12 feet and cased with 6 inch casing. Equipped with a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch centrifugal pump directly connected to a 2 H.P. electric motor installed at the eighteen foot level. The water is discharged into a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe line that conveys it to a fifty gallon drum placed on top of the mill, where it is used to concentrate scheelite ore. The mill is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T. 11 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.

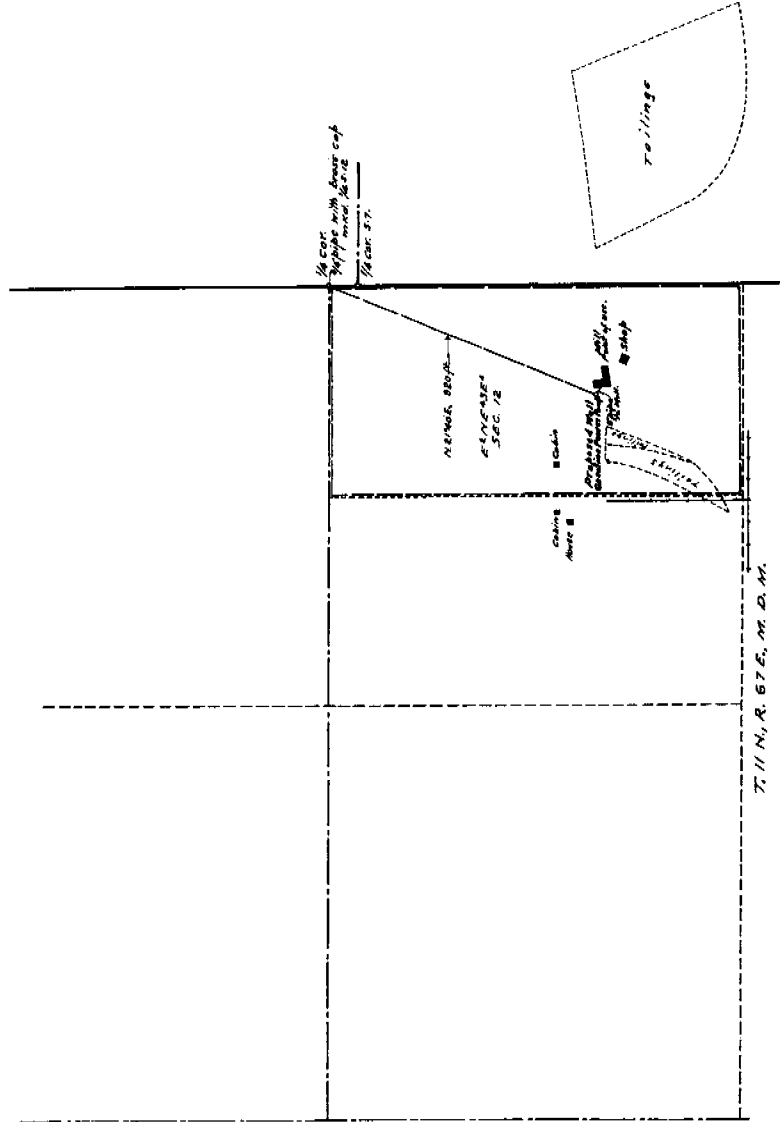
