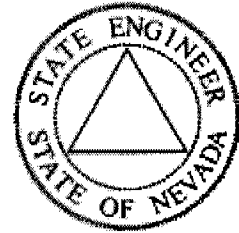

TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Bill H. Evans 1253 Oakridge Drive of Bountiful, County of Davis

State of Utah, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground sources (Drilled well) Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 5.4 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 21, T. 13 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the Northeast Corner of said Section 21 bears N. 45° 00' E., 141.42 feet distant. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land it should be stated.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source, and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 5.4 c.f.s. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 5.4 cubic feet per second, or a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 7, 1964
Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 7, 1964
Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 7, 1965
Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 7, 1965
Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 7, 1968
Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 7, 1968

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Reginald G. Lee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 21, T.13N., R.67E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 21 bears N. 53° 54' E., a distance of 116.5 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.
