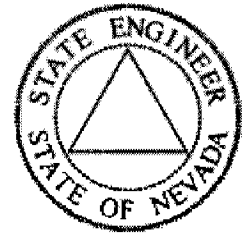

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 19, 1967
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 19, 1967
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 19, 1968
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 19, 1968
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 19, 1969
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 19, 1969
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 19, 1969

CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry C. Conrad, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 12, T.12N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Sec. 12 bears N. 73° 48' 36" E., a distance of 2,911.45 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: E. W. and Violet D. Patton

Amount of appropriation: 0.61 c.f.s., not to exceed 60.0 acre-feet per annum

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: June 16, 1965

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

15 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12, T.12N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
