## DEEP CREEK BAND.

The Whire House, May 29, 1912.
It is hereby orclered that the SIV. $\frac{7}{7}$ of the NE. $\frac{1}{4}$, the SE. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW. $\frac{7}{4}$, the NW. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE. $\frac{1}{6}$, and the NE. $\frac{1}{7}$ of the SW. $\frac{1}{4}$ of soe. 8 , and the S. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW. $\frac{7}{4}$ of sec. 0, 'T. $11 \mathrm{~S} ., \mathrm{R}$. 19 W . of the Salt Lake meridian, in the county of Tooele, State of Utah, be, and the same are hereby, reserved from settlement, entry, sale, or other disposal and set aside for school, agency, and other uecessary uses for the benefit of Indians on the public domain in the State of Utah, subject, however, to any valid existing rights of any persons thereto. Sme: Upor recommendation of the commanding geferal, Division of the Missouri, I have the honor to request that the followingdescribed tract on land in the Territory of Utah, efnbraced within the limits of the Uintalh Indian Reservation, created by Executive order dated October : 3,1801 s and act of Congress approved May 5, 1864 ( 13 Stats, 63), may be duly dechared and set apart by the Executive as a military reservation for the post of Fort Du Chesne, viz:

Beginning at a point 2 miles due north of the flagstatt of Fort Du Chesne, Utah Territory, and ruming thence duc west 1 mile, to the north vest corner; thence due south \& miles to the southwest corner; thence due east 2 miles to the sontheast corner; thence due north 3 miles to the northeast compr"; thence dite west 1 mile to the point of beginning. Area, 6 square miles- -2 by 3 .'

The Sceretary of the Interior states that there is no objection on the part of that department to the use of the teact in guestion for military purposes (the selection of which is the fesult of a mutual agreement), provided it be understood that the same be subject to such right, the, and interest as the Indians bave to and in said land: which shall be vacated whencver the interest of the Indians require it.

A sketch of the proposed military reservation is inclosed herewith.
