ndix D—United States List of  
 gered Native Fish and Wildlife  
 e was published in the FEDERAL  
 ER of Tuesday, August 25, 1970 (35  
 519) beginning on page 13519, a  
 al to amend Part 17 of Title 50,

Code of Federal Regulations by codifying  
 as Appendix D thereto a list of the species  
 of native fish and wildlife found to be  
 threatened with extinction.

Interested persons were given 30 days  
 in which to submit written comments,  
 suggestions, or objections with respect to  
 the proposed amendment to the Director,  
 Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife,  
 U.S. Department of the Interior, Wash-  
 ington, D.C. 20240.

All relevant matters presented have  
 been considered and it is determined  
 that the proposed amendment to be  
 adopted with the following changes:

1. Delete the Utah prairie dog—*Cynomys parvidens*. (The 3d mammal listed in the proposal.)
2. Change Texas red wolf—*Canis rufus rufus* to Red Wolf—*Canis rufus*. (The 8th mammal listed in the proposal.)
3. Change Large Kauai thrush—*Phaeornis obscurus obscurus* to Large Kauai thrush—*Phaeornis obscurus myadestina*. (The 31st bird listed in the proposal.)

A new Appendix D is added to 50 CFR  
 17 as follows:
