Re: GBWN Reply to SNWA Response to Motion for Declaratory Order of Scope and Implementation of Remedy Ordered by Supreme Court in *GBWN v. Taylor*

Dear Mr. King:

I am writing in response to your office's November 22, 2010 letter granting the Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) an extension until December 1st in which to file its response to the Great Basin Water Network's (GBWN's) October 15th Motion for Declaratory Order of Scope of Implementation of Remedy Ordered by Supreme Court.¹ To this date, we have not received a copy of SNWA's letter of November 18, requesting such an extension. In light of the additional extension granted to SNWA, cumulatively giving SNWA approximately six weeks to respond to GBWN's motion, and because GBWN's undersigned counsel will be travelling on business during the week of December 13, GBWN respectfully requests that it be granted an extension until December 22 to file its reply to SNWA's opposition.
