High summer is my resort's high season; best for us out here in winter particularly for tourism and ranching businesses

We need to clarify participants/protestant's status well before and unequivocally. This sets forth a fair and clear process and lessens the chances of your office addressing further legal initiatives.

The only equitable way this can proceed is to allow "new" protestants to participate without paying a new fee. All protestants need to be defined clearly before any hearings or any processes are set.

It is wise to have a prehearing conference so that it is clear who the protestants are. If your office is short on funds and seeks to move ahead on that basis, I suspect it will cost the state in other ways. It is extremely important that your office appears impartial and not an enabler of SNWA's wishes.
