**1. Norman L. Jones, Ph.D**

Norman Jones is currently a Professor in the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at Brigham Young University. He is also a consultant with Aquaveo, LLC. He is the co-author of CPB\_011. His Curriculum Vita is CPB\_013.

Dr. Jones received his Ph.D. from the University of Texas at Austin in Civil Engineering. He has extensive experience in groundwater modeling. He will testify on the information in CPB\_011 on the impact of the proposed SNWA wells on CPB water rights.

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**2. Alan L. Mayo, Ph.D**

Dr. Alan L. Mayo is currently a Professor of Hydrogeology at Brigham Young University and also managing partner of Mayo and Associates, LC, consultants in hydrogeology. He is the co-author of CPB\_011 and created CPB\_16. His Curriculum Vita is CPB\_014.

Dr. Mayo received his Ph.D. in hydrogeology from the University of Idaho and has extensive experience in groundwater issues. He will testify on the information in CPB\_009 on the groundwater resource in Spring Valley and the effect of the proposed SNWA well system on groundwater in Spring Valley.

**3. Bruce A. Roundy, Ph.D**

Dr. Bruce A. Roundy is currently a Professor in the Department of Plant and Wildlife Sciences at Brigham Young University. He received his Ph.D. in range management from Utah State University. He has extensive experience in vegetation of semiarid lands and soil and plant water relations. His Curriculum Vita is CPB\_15.

Dr. Roundy will testify on the information referenced in CPB\_007 concerning impacts of the proposed SNWA wells on vegetation, specifically in the area of CPB properties in northern Spring Valley.


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
