2. Jerald Anderson, citizen of EskDale, Millard County, Utah

Mr. Anderson will testify regarding Millard County's interest in monitoring and preserving groundwater levels in Snake Valley from unreasonable draw-down due to pumping in Spring Valley, as well protecting agricultural resources, grazing, vegetative, wildlife and air quality resources, and all of the resources identified for protection in the

Area of Interest defined in the Nevada Engineer approved September 8, 2006 Stipulation for Withdrawal of Protests in the earlier prior Spring Valley hearing. This testimony will not duplicate Mr. Smith's testimony.

3. Chad Winn, Juab County Commissioner

Mr. Winn will testify regarding Juab County's interest in monitoring and preserving groundwater levels in Snake Valley from unreasonable draw-down due to pumping in Spring Valley, as well protecting agricultural resources, grazing, vegetative, wildlife and air quality resources, and all of the resources identified for protection in the Area of Interest defined in the Nevada Engineer approved September 8, 2006 Stipulation for Withdrawal of Protests in the earlier prior Spring Valley hearing.

4. Ken Hill, Citizen residing in Partoun, Juab County, Utah

Mr. Hill will testify regarding Juab County's interest in monitoring and preserving groundwater levels in Snake Valley from unreasonable draw-down due to pumping in Spring Valley, as well protecting agricultural resources, grazing, vegetative, wildlife and air quality resources, and all of the resources identified for protection in the Area of Interest defined in the Nevada Engineer approved September 8, 2006 Stipulation for Withdrawal of Protests in the earlier prior Spring Valley hearing. This testimony will not duplicate Mr. Winn's testimony.
