RE: Call For Independent Advisory Committee Members

To Whom It May Concern:

The Division of Water Resources' new enforcement regulations went into effect July 1, 2009, as Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 532.

After a penalty is assessed for a violation, NAC 532 allows for a respondent to request a hearing before an independent advisory committee formed by the Director of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR). After such a hearing, this committee will then provide a recommendation to the State Engineer as to whether the penalty assessed should stand or be modified.

Anyone with knowledge and experience in Nevada water laws and regulations who is interested in becoming a member of the pool from which the DCNR Director can form a committee should submit a letter of intent and resume to the DCNR Director's Office, 901 S. Stewart St., Ste. 5001, Carson City, NV, 89701.

You will be informed by the DCNR Director if you are selected as part of the pool. Service on the committee will be determined at the time that an appeal is made by a respondent. There is no compensation for participating as a committee member.
