**Vacancy Announcement: WELL SUPERVISOR (Hydrologist)**

**Annual Salary:**

The salary will be contingent upon education and experience. Employee benefits include paid annual and sick leave, health, dental and vision insurance and the state retirement plan. Other optional benefits are available, including a deferred compensation plan.

**Recruitment Open to:** All qualified persons.

**Applications will be accepted until 5:00pm Monday, October 26, 2009.**

**Recruiting for:** A permanent full-time vacancy located within the Hydrology Section of the Division of Water Resources, Carson City, Nevada. In order to receive consideration, applicants must indicate their availability to work in this geographical location and must possess a valid Nevada Drivers License. A State of Nevada/FBI background check may be required of the selected applicant.

**The Position:** Reporting to the Chief, Hydrology Section, the position will perform a full spectrum of hydrologic assignments. Applicant should have a working knowledge of groundwater and surface water hydraulics, hydrologic processes and modeling, and should be familiar with current concepts and technologies relating to groundwater recharge and evapotranspiration. The position will evaluate the hydrologic aspects of applications and permits to appropriate waters of the State of Nevada, make determinations on the magnitude, extent and timing of hydrologic effects of the subject applications, and make recommendations to management detailing mitigation measures and monitoring requirements. The position will oversee regional monitor plans, hydrologic studies and reports which are required as a condition of permits, and will coordinate with applicants to design and implement monitoring programs and studies that will provide important information to ascertain the long-term effects of water development.

**To Qualify:** Applicant must have a professional level of understanding of hydrogeologic principles and processes. Graduation from college with a Bachelor of Science degree in hydrogeology, hydrology, or related field; **OR** an equivalent combination of education and experience in which the applicant has demonstrated possession of the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary for this position.
