WATER CONSERVATION PLAN
Public Water System ID Number NV0000903

CMC Joist and Deck, located in 8200 Woolery Way, Fallon, NV 89406 owns and operates a non-transient non-community public water system to provide service in restrooms, break rooms, fire suppression system and dust suppression. The system is supplied by groundwater pumped by a single well located within the facility. CMC Joist's population may change depending on production requirements. It is estimated that an average of 150 employees are served by the water system. CMC does not distribute or use water from its public system for any purposes outside its property.

This water conservation plan is prepared and adopted by CMC pursuant to Chapter 540, sections 131 to 151 of the Nevada Revised Statutes. Because the statutes are directed to community systems or distribution systems that operate for profit, CMC will adapt the pertinent provisions of the statutes into this plan.

1. Plan to provide incentives – does not apply
2. Written views and recommendations on the plan - CMC will solicit comments from the users of its water system by posting notices in common areas. Comments with merit will be evaluated and incorporated in the plan accordingly.
3. This plan will be submitted to the Division of Water Resources for review and approval as well as filing for informational purposes.

Actions taken by CMC in the conservation of water

CMC will implement methods of public education in order to increase awareness of the limited supply of water in Nevada and the need to conserve water. Information will be provided in the form of signs or poster in break rooms, rest rooms, common areas and other areas where water conservation can be enhanced. Employees will also be reminded of water conservation practices during regular training sessions such as stormwater pollution prevention, hazardous waste management and diverse safety topics.

CMC will replace water fixtures as needed with low flow fixtures in order to reduce water usage. The CMC maintenance department will maintain facilities such that leakage in water supplies, inaccuracies in water meters are identified and repaired promptly.

CMC's water system is supplied by groundwater pumped from a well located onsite. CMC will keep track of water elevations as well as water qualities in order to predict and be prepared to take alternate measures to provide water to the facility if a drought presents.

This plan will become effective and will begin implementation on the date of approval from the Division. The plan will be revised as required, but no later than 5 years from the date it becomes effective.
