







# Nevada State Water Plan [Tentative] Timeline



#### Introduction

## **Comment:** Will the State Water Plan set new policies or provide recommendations? Will recommendations be guidance or mandates?

- The State Water Plan will provide recommendations
- The State Water Plan will not (and cannot) mandate actions
- However, some recommendations may ultimately influence policy and/or require policy changes to be implemented


#### **Comment: Will the State Water Plan address water quality issues?**

- The State Water Plan will mention the importance of simultaneously considering water quantity and quality
- However, water quality management is outside the scope of DWR's authority and will not be a major focus

### Nevada State Water Plan

#### **Climate & Water Resources**

- Climate section is being reviewed internally before being sent to an external reviewer (DRI)
  - Topics: "average" Nevada climate, projected changes in climate, potential climate impacts to water resources
- Water resources section being finalized internally
  - Focused on groundwater and surface water availability
- Goal: Send this section to the SAG in Oct./Nov. to review before the next SAG meeting (likely early Dec.)



#### **NEXT STEPS**


- Estimate current statewide water use
- Outline potential future statewide water demands
- Collaboratively discuss water resource challenges and develop recommendations for improving water management
- The goal is to have the first full draft ready for public comment in Summer 2024

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## NDWR Publications: Groundwater

- 1. Pumpage and crop inventory reports
  - 86 basins annually, 15 track IRR only
- 2. 2017 Statewide Pumpage Report
- 3. Next Statewide Pumpage Report
  - Work will start early 2024
  - Likely a 6 month process
  - Incorporates data from the 2020 or 2021 annual reports




STATEWIDE GROUNDWATER PUMPAGE INVENTORY

### WATER USE DATA SOURCES: 2017 PUMPAGE



1.2 million acrefeet pumped in 2017

Data by basin and county

#### **Estimation Methods:**

- Meter readings
- Crop-based calculations
- Field investigations
- Full duty if no other information available



#### **USGS Publications**

- 2015 Water Use Report
  - Includes surface water estimates—methods unclear
- No timeline for next report (2020 data)

#### **Surface Water Use**

- Fully appropriated
- Limited use reporting
- Availability varies year to year

#### **Possible Data Sources**

- Municipal water suppliers' records
- Irrigation districts' records

NDWR estimates 4-5 million acre-feet of surface water used annually
